Air Quality Supplementary Planning Document 2016

Notice is hereby given that Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council adopted its Air Quality Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) 2016 on 18th October 2016 in accordance with the above regulations. The Air Quality SPD was approved by Council on 18th October 2016 and came into effect from 18th October 2016.

The Air Quality Supplementary Planning Document sets out guidance for dealing with air quality. It is aimed at anyone involved in the submission and decision-making of planning applications where air quality needs to be addressed.
