

**SANDWELL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14 2**

**Temporary Prohibition of Driving Chapel Lane, Great Barr & A34
Birmingham Road, Great Barr**

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice that on 1st July 2024 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the following roads in Great Barr

Chapel Lane will be closed from its junction with A34 Birmingham Road to its junction with Coronation Road (anticipated dates 1st – 5th July 2024)

Vehicles will be diverted via: A34 Birmingham Road, Queslett Road, Beacon Road, Old Hall Lane, Pinfold Lane and vice- versa

Vehicular and Pedestrian access must be maintained to Chapel Lane on 4th July 2024 (Election day) as there is a Polling Station located in the road.

A34 Birmingham Road, vehicles will be prohibited from turning right into Chapel Lane off A34 Birmingham Road (anticipated dates 1st – 5th July 2024)

Vehicles will be diverted via A34 Birmingham Road to the gap in the central reservation where a U turn can be made, and the main diversion route be joined.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate the continuation of works to install a new electricity cable (already ongoing on Walsall's part of Chapel Lane) by National Grid Electricity Distribution

The provisions of this notice will be followed up by a Temporary Traffic Regulation and works in Chapel Lane are anticipated to continue until 2nd August 2024.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 1st July 2024 and for a period not exceeding 21 days.
