## THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990 SECTION 69 EXTENSION OF THE CHURCH SQUARE, OLDBURY CONSERVATION AREA

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 69(1) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, the Borough Council of Sandwell has determined that the area described in the Schedule to this Notice is an area of special architectural or historic interest and that it is desirable to preserve or enhance its character or appearance. It has accordingly extended the Church Square, Oldbury Conservation Area so as to include this area.

The principle effects of this area being included within a conservation area are as follows:-

- 1. The Council is under a duty to prepare proposals to ensure the preservation or enhancement of the area.
- 2. Consents must be obtained from the Council for the demolition of any building in the area.
- 3. Special publicity must be given to planning applications for development in the area.
- 4. In carrying out any functions under the Planning Acts (and, in particular, in determining applications for planning permission and listed building consent), the Council and the Secretary of State are required to take into account the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character of appearance of the area.
- 5. Six weeks notice must be given to the Council before works are carried out to any tree in the area.
