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### THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL

#### (Sandwell Borough Waiting and Loading Restrictions)

#### (Traffic Regulation order No. 19) 2024.

The Borough Council of Sandwell ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and under the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended (whether generally or in relation to the area of the Council) ("the 1991 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Sandwell (Sandwell Borough, Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order No.19) 2024 and shall come into operation on NNth NNNNN 2024
- 2 The restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under any other enactment.
- 3 In this Order
  - a) "Authorised person" means an employee or agent of the Council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the Council under this Order.
  - b) "Civil Enforcement Officer" means an Authorised person by or on behalf of the Council to enforce the restrictions in this Order and issue Penalty Contravention Notices.
  - c) "Council" means Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council;
  - "Dispensation Certificate" means a Certificate or Virtual Certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council for the purposes of this Order permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of road where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited;
  - e) "Handheld Device" means a handheld computer (including mobile phone) used by a Civil Enforcement Officer whilst carrying out duties
  - f) *"household"* means the occupants of a dwelling used or suitable for use as a separate dwelling.
  - g) *"junction"* means the intersection of the outside edge of the first highway with the outside edge of the second highway.
  - h) *"motor vehicle"* has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
  - i) "Owner" has the same meaning as Section 92 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, and Owner shall have the meaning in the The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 in respect of a person who is served a penalty contravention notice
  - j) "Parking disc" means the disc issued by the Local Authority complying with the requirements of Regulation 8(5) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began.

k) "relevant position" in respect of: -

(a) a disabled person's badge and Parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000, as amended; and

(b) A Parking disc is displayed in the "relevant position" if –

• the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle, or

• where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle,

so that, when marked to show the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

- I) *"universal service provider"* has the same meaning given by Section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011.
- m) "Virtual Certificate" means an electronic record of a Certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of road where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited;
- n) "Virtual Dispensation Certificate" means an electronic record of a Certificate or Virtual Certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council that is required to be accessible using a Handheld Device on an electronic database approved by the council for the purposes of this Order permitting a specified vehicle to wait in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of road where the waiting of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited;

#### Section 1: No waiting at any time

- **1/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 1/02. For the purposes of Clause 1/01, a motor vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if
  - i) the motor vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) any point in that length of road is below the vehicle or its load (if any).
  - iii) "For the purposes of **Clause 1/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road, it will be considered a new contravention from midnight on a rolling/daily basis.
- **1/03.** Nothing in **Clause 1/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order;
  - (c) to enable a vehicle, which is a universal service povider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.;
  - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (e) to enable a motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- 1/04. Nothing in Clause 1/01 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a motor vehicle which displays in the relevant position, a valid disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the motor vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 for a period not exceeding 3 hours (provided that this waiting is not during a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same sides of lengths of road).

#### Section 3: No stopping at school entrances during prescribed hours

- **3/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to stop in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 3 to this Order during the hours prescribed in Column 5 of the said schedule.
  - i) "For the purposes of **Clause 3/01**, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- **3/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 3/01**, a motor vehicle shall be taken to stop on a length of road if the motor vehicle is stationary.
- 3/03. Nothing in Clause 3/01 applies -
  - (a) To a motor vehicle where the person in control of the motor vehicle
    - i) is required by law to stop;
    - ii) is obliged to do so to avoid an accident or to avoid injury or damage to property;
    - iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control;
  - (b) to a motor vehicle used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
  - (c) to a vehicle which is stationary to enable it to be used for the purpose of
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 of this Order;

but only if the motor vehicle cannot be used for one of those purposes without stopping on the sides and lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 3** to this Order.

#### Section 5: Limited waiting during prescribed hours

- **5/01.** Subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 5 to this Order during the hours prescribed in Column 5 of the said schedule -
  - (a) for a period exceeding the length of time specified in **Column 6** of **Schedule 5**;
  - (b) during any period separated by an interval of less than the duration specified in Column
    7 of Schedule 5 from a previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same side and length of road.
- **5/02.** For the purposes of **Clause 5/01**, a motor vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if
  - i) the motor vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) any point in that length of road is below the vehicle of its load (if any)
  - iii) "For the purposes of Clause 5/01, a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of the order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period."
- **5/03.** Nothing in **Clause 5/01** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary -
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at, premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 5 of this Order;
  - (c) to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service.
  - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (e) to enable a motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- **5/04.** Nothing in **Clause 5/01** of this Order shall apply to a vehicle that is displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
