Temporary Prohibition of Crosswells Road and Station Road, Oldbury

The Borough Council of Sandwell hereby gives Notice that on 3rd December 2024 no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed on Crosswells Road, Oldbury from the junction with Station Road to the gable end of property number 3 and Station Road, Oldbury from the junction of Western Road (eastern side) to the junction of Crosswells Road (access to frontages within the closure will be maintained, but only when safety permits).

A traffic diversion will be signed via Western Road, Tat Bank Road and Vicarage Road.

A further traffic diversion route will be signed via Joinings Bank, Vicarage Road, Tat Bank Road and Western Road.

Thompson Road, Highbury Road, Bloxcidge Street and Jackson Street will be signed to provide local access to both diversion routes advised above.

The purpose and reason for the issue of this Notice is to facilitate emergency access to repair a water main by Onsite on behalf of South Staffs Water.

This Notice will remain effective and in force from 3rd December 2024 (24hr) and for a period not exceeding 21 days. It is anticipated that the work will take until 12th December 2024 to complete.
