

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL

(Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order No. 14) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Sandwell (“the Council”) has made the above named Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act.

The effect of this Order would be to amend The Borough Council of Sandwell (Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order No. 14) 2019 (“the 2019 Order”) as follows:

- a. Introduce ‘No Loading At Any Time’ restrictions along part(s) of Park Street, Oldbury and Park Lane, Oldbury

A copy of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at Sandwell Council House, Freeth Street, Oldbury, West Midlands, B69 3DE during usual opening hours or online at www.sandwell.gov.uk (by following Road, travel and parking < Roads, highways and pavements < Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO) from the homepage).

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
