Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council is carrying out a review of the polling districts and polling places within the borough. This is required under section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

All submissions must be received by Friday 30 August 2019. In accordance with the Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006, any correspondence will be published on our website on completion of the review.
